## Bunny Egg Holder

Color "zendoodled" bunny ears to make a fanciful holder for an Easter egg.

## You will need:


- <u>Bunny wraps</u> printed on card stock (color/pattern of choice)
- Zendoodle bunny ears printed on white copy paper
- Colored markers or pencils
- Glue stick
- Scissors (scalloped or regular)
- Easter egg

Display a <u>picture of a completed Bunny Egg Holder</u> so crafters can see how cute the project is.


## **Directions:**


- 1. Choose a bunny ear pattern and color both ears. Cut out the colored ears.
- 2. Cut out a bunny wrap.
- 3. Turn the wrap facedown and glue the decorated ears to the corresponding ears on the wrap.
- 4. With the bunny facing out, glue the ends of the wrap so they overlap by about 1/2" as shown.
- 5. Set the holder upright and place your egg inside.
